RECEIVE PROJECT UPDATES FROM DEPARTMENT HEADS/ELECTED OFFICIALS. County Engineer Cathy Nicholas said road crews hauled the first 10 miles of rock in each motor grader district and are starting on the next 10 miles. Washburn Road is closed near the landfill this week for a culvert replacement.

Mike Hendrickson, Director of County Conservation, said the county received a Destination Iowa grant of approximately \$1.4 million to complete nearly 9.5 miles of the Cedar Valley Nature Trail in southern Black Hawk County.

Kaitlin Emrich, Deputy Director of the Health Department, said the Centers for Disease Control upgraded Black Hawk County last week to medium risk for Covid-19 spread. The rate is near high risk, so another upgrade could happen this week.

**CONSENT AGENDA ENDS**

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Schwartz.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the CONTRACT EXTENSION between Black Hawk County and the Cedar Bend Humane Society effective July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023 for Basic Animal Care Services at a rate of \$27,834.36 per year (\$2,319.53 per month), and with an annual increase of 1% for all contract fees for the unincorporated areas of Black Hawk County be approved and direct the Chair to sign for same and to receive and place on file the Certificate of Insurance with the County Auditor.

Trelka's original motion was for a three-year contract extension. CBHS Executive Director Kristy Gardner said the agency saw an increase in service to the county during Fiscal Year 2022, handling 143 animals from the unincorporated area, including 115 cats and 28 dogs. Future monthly reports to the county will include more information about the disposition of strays brought in or picked up by CBHS. Little noted the agency does not handle calls after 5 p.m., and that has created concerns by sheriff's deputies. Little suggested only approving a one-year contract. Laylin asked how the contract cost is set. Gardner said the annual price covers all services except when CBHS is called out to pick up an animal, which is an extra \$25 fee. Gardner said issues with sheriff's deputies mostly involved requests for services the agency is not contracted to provide. Little questioned whether it would be cheaper for the county to price the contract per animal. Gardner said she would need to do calculations before answering, noting the contract structure has not been changed or discussed for many years. Schwartz said he favored a one-year contract at this time. He also wanted to see proposals for a catch-neuter-release program and a one-time spay and neuter blitz. Gardner said she was open to those discussions. Trelka then amended his motion to the one-year contract term Schwartz's consent.

Laylin moved the following resolution seconded by Trelka.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Iowa County Engineers Association's application for funding for Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant on behalf of the 99 counties in Iowa, including Black Hawk County, be approved and direct the Chair to sign for same as recommended by Catherine Nicholas, County Engineer.

Moved by Little, seconded by Laylin to direct the County Auditor to advertise for a public hearing/bid opening to be held at 9:05 a.m. on Tuesday, August 16, 2022, in Board Room 201 of the Black Hawk County Courthouse, 316 E. 5th Street, Waterloo,

Iowa on the proposed purchase of one (1) Single Axle Dump Truck and one (1) Tandem Axle Dump Truck for the Black Hawk County Engineer's Department. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE BOARD ACTION – Funding for Family & Children's Council's Community Services Application. Trelka recused himself from the vote because he's been asked to join the FCC board. Finance Director James Perry said the board allocated \$100,000 from its general fund reserves to cover community services grants this fiscal year and received the following requests: Family & Children's Council, \$10,000; Focus on Diabetes, \$25,000; Grow Cedar Valley, \$50,000; Northeast Iowa Food Bank, \$50,000; Operation Threshold, \$20,000; and Riverview Center, \$56,500. Laylin said FCC was looking to make up for the loss of a large donor for the baby safety program.

Laylin moved the following resolution seconded by Little.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Black Hawk County authorize \$5,000 in funding per Family & Children's Council's Community Services Application.

AYES: Laylin, Little, Schwartz, White.

NAYS: None.

ABSTAIN: Trelka. Resolution adopted.

DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE BOARD ACTION – Funding for Focus on Diabetes' Community Services Application.

Laylin said there were indications portions of the program listed in the application may not start until Fiscal Year 2023, but she said the program holds annual awareness events and does community outreach. Assistant County Attorney Michael Treinen said the county will only pay for services invoiced from the program that have been identified as public purposes by the Board of Supervisors. Laylin said the program is entirely volunteer-based. She asked if the county money could be used for volunteer recruitment. Treinen said he would need to research that question but recommended the funding be specified for services only.

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Schwartz.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Black Hawk County authorize \$5,000 in funding per Focus on Diabetes' Community Services Application.

AYES: Laylin, Little, Schwartz, Trelka, White.

NAYS: None. Resolution adopted.

DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE BOARD ACTION – Funding for Grow Cedar Valley's Community Services Application. Trelka recused himself because he will be doing business with Grow Cedar Valley. Laylin recused herself because she previously worked at the agency for 25 years and still has friends on the staff. White said he believes the county should return to past practice and have a committee recommend the grant awards. White moved to approve \$50,000 in funding. Grow Cedar Valley CEO Cary Darrah said the agency would do its best with any amount awarded and was working to strengthen relationships with rural communities in the county. Schwartz moved to approve \$15,000 in funding. Little said he was not sure he favored any funding.

White moved the following resolution seconded by Schwartz.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Black Hawk County authorize \$25,000 in funding per Grow Cedar Valley's Community Services Application.

AYES: Schwartz, White.

NAYS: Little.

ABSTAIN: Laylin, Trelka. Resolution failed.

DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE BOARD ACTION – Funding for Northeast Iowa Food Bank's Community Services Application. White recused himself from voting as a former Food Bank board member. Schwartz recused himself from voting as a current ex-officio board member.

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Little.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Black Hawk County authorize \$20,000 in funding per Northeast Iowa Food Bank's Community Services Application.

DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE BOARD ACTION – Funding for Riverview Center's Community Services Application. Laylin said Riverview Center is the only agency in Black Hawk County providing this type of service to victims of sexual assault.

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Laylin.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Black Hawk County authorize \$15,000 in funding per Riverview Center's Community Services Application.

AYES: Laylin, Little, Schwartz, Trelka, White.

NAYS: None.

Resolution adopted.

Perry noted the board only awarded \$55,000 of the \$100,000 allocated for community services grants. Schwartz suggested a second round of applications could be considered later in the year.
