County Auditor Grant Veeder said that these rates are already in effect. He said the Auditor of State conducted an audit of payments to precinct election officials in several counties in the state, and informed Black Hawk County that it should have a specific resolution setting the rates as opposed to simply approving them in the budget.

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Laylin.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the Time Keeping System, with an estimated cost of \$50,000, to be paid for with American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds.

ARP Committee Chair and Assistant County Attorney Mike Treinen, Information Technology Director Al Yu, and Supervisor Laylin said that the system allows employees to log their work time remotely, reducing the public health impact of employees entering the workplace during a pandemic.

AYES: Laylin, Little, Schwartz, Trelka, White.

NAYS: None. Resolution adopted.

The Board discussed the Pinecrest Elevator ARP project, with an estimated cost of \$40,000. Maintenance Superintendent Rory Geving said that two years ago, just before the pandemic, he had raised the question of whether the elevator, which is smaller and less visible than the main Pinecrest elevator, should be repaired or disabled. Employee sentiment was originally to disable it, but during the pandemic employees started to see it as an alternative that allowed distancing. He said that if repaired it would cost \$1800 a year to maintain. Little said that it wasn't necessary during the pandemic and wondered why it would be needed now. Geving said that besides distancing it is a backup in case the main elevator breaks down. Little asked how often the main elevator was shut down in the past two years. Geving said it was out of service for some short periods. Laylin suggested putting the project on hold and other supervisors agreed. Geving said that Iowa law requires that an elevator be disabled if it is taken out of service, a process that would cost \$5000.

The Board discussed the Evidence Intake Facility ARP project, with an estimated cost of \$1,800,000. Captain Mark Herbst of the Sheriff's Office said that Baker Tilly, the county's ARP consultant, eloquently justified the need for the new facility. Treinen said that Baker Tilly staff gave him the impression that their justification was borderline and perhaps the project shouldn't be on their Burden of Proof continuum. He thought it may be best to use ARP revenue loss funds and said that in the unlikely event that the project would undergo a Treasury Department audit it was difficult to say if it would stand up, given that it is not a facility for congregant settings. Herbst said that while relatively few people would be there, they work with communicable diseases, and the current space has a hazardous environment. Trelka said he supports the project, but he thought that Treinen and Herbst should converse together with Baker Tilly staff. Schwartz said that he didn't think this would be the best use of revenue loss funds, and that there should be a strategic plan for that most flexible part of the funds.

Trelka moved the following resolution seconded by Laylin.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the PERSONNEL REQUISITION for an Assistant County Attorney, (full time, replacement) in the County Attorney's Office with a start date no sooner than December 16, 2022, be approved, as recommended by Brian Williams, County Attorney.

AYES: Laylin, Little, Schwartz, Trelka, White.

NAYS: None. Resolution adopted.

Moved by Trelka, seconded by Laylin to hire temporary staff for the Board office front desk to provide Board and Finance Director support, using either a temporary employee or a staffing agency, not to exceed \$30,000, as recommended by Michelle Weidner, Finance Director.

White asked why so much. Weidner said she wants to figure out what other responsibilities could be assigned to the permanent position, and it may take some months before she would like to post it. Motion carried.

ANY REPORTS OR INFORMATION FROM THE BOARD. Trelka offered congratulations to newly appointed Waterloo Police Chief Joe Leibold. White noted that today is the 59<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. He and Schwartz recounted what Kennedy meant to them and their families.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
