## Why Have a Certified Manager?

- ◇ To increase food service worker knowledge and skills.
- ◇ To ensure food preparation is completed in a safe and sanitary manner.
- ◇ To protect the health of your customers and employees.

Pursuant to the adoption of the 2013 FDA Model Food Code, Iowa Facilities are required to have a Certified Food Manager. (2-102.12(A) Certified Food).
