 - a. is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to the damage to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting therefrom, and
 - b. is caused in whole or in party by any negligent act or omission of the permittee or its subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable regardless of whether or not it is caused in party by a party indemnified hereunder.
